Topics of Discussion:

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Public Works of the Town of Reading will hold a public hearing in the Conference Room, Reading Town Hall, 16 Lowell Street, Reading, MA at **2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, March 13, 2024.**

This hearing is in response to the petition of **Verizon New England**, seeking permission to lay and maintain underground conduits, with wires and cables to be placed therein, under the surface of the following public way:

Woburn Street: Place one (1) four-inch (4") PVC conduit approximately \pm 35'. Starting from existing manhole, MH52 in a southerly direction, crossing Woburn Street to 18 Woburn Street. Said manhole is located on the easterly side of Sanborn Street.

This petition is necessary to accommodate new construction.

Also for permission to lay and maintain underground conduits, manholes, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making new connections with such poles and buildings as it may desire for distributing purposes.

Said work to be done substantially in accordance with the petition and plan filed in the office of the Town Engineer, lower level of the Reading Town Hall.
